## Rules of Respect and Civility of Maison Assibi-RJLL



- All rooms are for single occupancy only;
- No alcoholic beverages or drugs will be tolerated in the hostel or on its grounds;
- No party or event will be tolerated without the prior authorization of management;
- I remain respectful at all times with my colleagues, roomers, employees, maintenance workers, chefs, neighbours and others:
- No verbal and physical violence or intimidation will be tolerated and will be subject to immediate expulsion, without any notice;
- I respect the dress code at all times. Thus, I wear indoor shoes and I make sure to cover my chest;
- I avoid making noise at all times out of respect for day and night workers;
- I am concerned about the volume of the television or the music and I use headphones as often as possible;
- I use the common areas (living room, dining room, locker room and bathrooms) respectfully, remembering that I do
  not live alone here. Hence, I replace what I moved and pick up my personal items;
- I pay particular attention to the furniture in order to keep everything in perfect condition;
- All breakages must be reported immediately to the cook on duty;
- If any breakage is detected upon your arrival, you must report it immediately to the cook, otherwise, the repair
  costs will have to be billed to you;
- I use shared bathrooms, so I pick up all my personal belongings before leaving the bathroom, otherwise, they will be thrown away;
- I make sure to take off my boots or shoes and leave them in the locker room, neatly stored in the place designated for me:
- I make sure to leave my work clothes in the dryer (DRY) of the drills or at my workplace;
- I use the washers and dryers made available to me and make sure to pick up my laundry when finished;
- It is forbidden to wash your work clothes in the washing machines made available to you;
- I make sure to follow the rules that the chef will have established for the operation of the kitchen;
- If the chef is in the kitchen, I respect his workspace;
- I eat in the dining room or the living room and I bring back my dirty dishes;
- I don't leave food in my room to avoid bad smells and unwanted insects;
- I eat until I am full, but I avoid waste by asking for too much food,
- I always use the outdoor ashtrays that are available to me to throw away my cigarette butts: no cigarette butts on the ground;
- I do not leave vehicles running unnecessarily.
